

Regular Meeting
July 7, 1941.

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held Monday July 7th., 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Atty. Zimmerman, Chief of Police Hansen, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Everhart, Gesik, Koehler, Porter, Reynolds and Stefani. Councilman Pfister absent.

Minutes of the June meeting were read and approved.

City Treasurer John Eid read his report for the second quarter of 1941. Motion was made, seconded and carried that the Treasurers report be accepted subject to audit of the Finance Committee.

The Communication of Mrs. H.E. Brown was referred to the Street Comm.

On motion, the matter of a caretaker at the Cemetery was referred back to the Cemetery Committee.

Ordinance #330, to amend the rules and regulations of Zion Cemetery relating to permanent maintenance came up for final action. On vote of the Council was passed yeas 7, nays 0.

Councilman Koehler recommended that the Council borrow enough from Light & Water Sinking fund to fix up Wait Park, Repayment to be made to the Light & Water Sinking Fund by placing a Park item in the Budget.

Motion was made, seconded and carried that the Park Committee get estimated on various size swimming pools.


Councilman Stefani requested the use of the grader at the Airport for two days. Motion was made, seconded and carried that the grader and an operator be furnished the airport two days at no charge.
