

Regular meeting.
August 4, 1941.

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held Monday August 4th., 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Atty. Zimmerman, Chief of Police Hansen, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Everhart, Gesik, Koehler, and Stefan. Councilmen Pfister, Porter and Reynolds absent.

Minutes of the July meeting were read and approved.

Communications from the Volunteer Fire Dept., The Clausen Family, The State Fire Marshall and the League of Oregon Cities were read by the Recorder.

On motion, the above claims were ordered paid. Yeas 5, nays 0.

Chas. Harshman, spokesman for a group of residents along South Second Ave., addressed the Council, requesting that something be done to allay the dust along this street. This matter was referred to the Street Committee for consideration. The matter of parking strips was discussed at length. The City Atty. was instructed to draw up an ordinance governing parking strips along streets.

Mr. Lent stated that more water would be needed. Also reported that the new transformers and meters had been received.

The matter of Frank Kendall's vacation was left with the Committee.

On motion, seconded and carried the Mayor was instructed to name a Budget Committee. Mayor Vinyard announced the Budget Committee as follows: George Bates, Wilmer Sandsness, George Cattley, E.A. Krueger, John Koehler, Peter Kylo, Walter A. Meek and M.M. Graham.

After some discussion motion was made, seconded and carried that Lester Hess be allowed \$15.00 per month additional for Cemetery work, making a total of \$40.00 per month for Cemetery care.

There being no further business on motion the Council adjourned.
