

Regular Meeting.  
September 2, 1941.

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held Tuesday September 2nd., 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Atty. Zimmerman, Chief of Police Hansen, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Everhart, Gesik, Koehler, Porter and Reynolds. Councilman Stefani reported later, Councilman Pfister absent.

On motion the above claims were ordered paid. Yeas 7, nays 0.

Was reported that the State Industrial Accident Commission had taken no action on the Fred Clausen claim. After discussion Atty. Zimmerman was instructed to take this matter up with the Commission.

After discussing the need for more water, motion was made, seconded and carried that the Committee have Mr. Hornig drill a six inch test well at the springs to determine if more water is available there.

Fire Chief Kraft reported two fire alarms was answered during the month one on the Fred Dietz property, outside of the city limits, with about a \$25.00 loss. The other in town, no loss. Also reported that dry grass and other fire hazards had been removed from several vacant lots. Fire Chief Kraft requested some financial assistance from the Council to enable several members of the fire dept. to attend the state convention of Firemen. Motion was made, seconded and carried that \$75.00 be allowed the Fire Dept. to help pay expenses of the members attending the Convention.

The matter of the parking strip in front of Mrs. H.E. Brown's property, discussion of which was held at previous meetings, was left to Mr. Koehler to work out.

Councilman Gesik reported that a gun had been purchased for the night watchman. The matter of a night off each week for Mr. Kendall was discussed. On motion, seconded and carried this was left with the Committee for consideration.

Ordinance #331 Specifying the width of City Streets dedicated or layed out within the city limits of Canby was passed on first reading.

Mayor Vinyard announced the appointment of Dr. C.H. Barr as City Health Officer, on motion seconded and carried appointment was approved by the Council.

There being no further business, on motion the Council adjourned.
