

Special Meeting.
September 26, 1940.

A special meeting of the Council was held Thursday September 26th. 1940, 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Chief of Police Hansen, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Everhart, Porter, Reynolds and Stefani. Councilman Pfister reported later. Councilmen Gesik and Koehler absent.

Mayor Vinyard announced that the meeting had been called to meet with the Budget Committee and to adopt a Budget for the year 1941.

The Secretary of the Budget Committee, Mr. E. A. Krueger, read the minutes of the Budget Committee meeting. The proposed levy of Budget Committee was as follows:

Councilman Porter suggested that something should be put in the Budget to take care of work on the Park property.

Motion was made, seconded and carried that \$600.00 be added to the proposed levy for street lights and electricity at the City Hall.

Motion was made, seconded and carried ^{that} \$750.00 be added to the proposed levy for a Park fund.

Motion was made, seconded and carried that the levy for Labor and material be increased to \$ 815.00, and the Emergency Fund be increased to \$700.00.

On motion, seconded and carried the proposed Budget as ammended was adopted as follows:
