Ordinance #325, levying atax on all the taxable property within the City Limits of Canby was read by the Recorder. On vote of the Council Ordinance #325 was passed on first reading and ordered published.

After some discussion motion was made, seconded and carried that the Cemetery Committee be authorized to construct an adequate building at the Cemetery, the pumphouse part be be made frost proof.

Councilman Everhart was instructed to have billheads for the Cemetery printed also to obtain additional blue prints for the Cemetery There being no further business on motion the Council adjourned.
