

Special Meeting.  
November 7, 1940.

A special meeting of the Council was held Thursday November 7th., 8'o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard Chief of Police Hansen, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Everhart, Gesik, Pfister and Porter. Absent Atty. Zimmerman and Councilmen Koehler, Reynolds and Stefani.

Mayor Vinyard announced that the meeting was called to canvas the vote of the regular city election held November 5th. 1940.

Whereupon the Recorder read the canvas of the votes as follows:

For Mayor, two year term.

J.R. Vinyard 422, F.T. Cutsforth 2, M.J. Lee 1, George Nelson 1, H.N. Everhart 2.

For Treasurer, two year term.

John Eid 428, T.H. Arestad 1.

For Councilmen, four year term.

F.T. Cutsforth 418, H.N. Everhart 390, R. Gesik 390, B.P. Pfister 398, Geo. F. Bates 7, Geo. Hardesty 1, Sam Amundson 3, Ed Shull 1, Chas. Harshman 1, Jack Wallace 1, Roy Mangus 1, Otto Krueger 1, J.R. Vinyard 1.

At the direction of the Council Councilman Porter proclaimed J.R. Vinyard duly elected to the office of Mayor for the ensuing term of two years.

Mayor Vinyard then issued a proclamation declaring the election of the other officers as follows:

F.T. Cutsforth reelected Councilman for four year term.

John Eid reelected City Treasurer for two year term.

There being no further business on motion the Council adjourned.
