

Regular Meeting.
January 2, 1940.

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held Tuesday January 2nd., 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Atty. Zimmerman, Chief of Police Hansen, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Everhart, Koehler, Pfister, Porter and Stefani. Absent, Councilmen Gesik and Reynolds.

Minutes of the regular December meeting and special meeting of December 19th. were read and approved.

On motion the above claims were approved for payment. Yeas 6, Nays 0.

A Mr. Griffith of Portland addressed the Council regarding pin ball machines.

Mr. Lent gave a report for the Light & Water Dept. for the year 1939, also stated that work was started on the settling tank and pumphouse at the new well. Also recommended that a new 20HP pump be installed at the new well. Mayor Vinyard congratulated Mr. Lent on his report for 1939.

After some consideration motion was made and seconded that the Water Committee be authorized to call for bids on a 20 HP pump installed. Motion carried.

Fire Chief Kraft gave the annual Fire Dept. report for the year 1939. There were 28 calls answered with a total loss of \$210.00.

After some discussion the matter of a building to house the grader was referred to the Sts. & P.P. Comm. for recommendations.

Ordinance #321, authorizing the purchase of new fire fighting equipment came up for final action. On vote of the Council ordinance #321 was passed, Yeas 6, nays 0.

Ordinance #322, authorizing the purchase of a street grader came up for final action. On vote of the Council ordinance #322 was passed, yeas 6, nays 0.

On motion, seconded and carried, yeas 6, nays 0, two bills of the Neep Equipment Co. for \$998.45 and 86.25, total of \$1,084.70 were allowed, and to be paid when the Council accepts the new fire truck.

There being no further business on motion the Council adjourned.
