

Special Meeting.
January 15, 1940.

A special meeting of the Council was held Monday January 15th. 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Atty. Zimmerman, Chief of Police Hansen, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Everhart, Koehler, Pfister, Porter, Reynolds and Stefani. Absent Councilman Gesik.

Mayor Vinyard stated that the meeting was called to consider a new electric rate ordinance.

Ordinance #323, providing rates for the consumers of electric current within the City of Canby, was read by the Recorder. On Motion, seconded and carried, ordinance #323 was passed on first reading.

On motion, seconded and carried ordinance #323 was ordered published.

Mr. Merle Wright addressed the Council regarding insurance on City owned vehicles.

Mr. Koehler reported on the property available for a building to house City owned equipment.

There being no further business, on motion the Council adjourned.
