

Regular Meeting.  
February 5, 1940.

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held Monday Feb. 5th., 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Atty. Zimmerman, Chief of Police Hansen, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Everhart, Gesik, Koehler, Pfister, Porter Reynolds and Stefani.

Mayor Vinyard introduced the Student Mayor, Glenn Cuddibach, who in turn introduced to the Council the other Student Officials as elected by the High School Student Body to officiate for the day.

Minutes of the regular January meeting and Special meeting of January 15th. were read and approved.

A letter from the Volunteer Fire Dept., stating that Christ Kraft Jr., had been elected Fire Chief for the year 1940, also a letter from the Canby Library Board giving a report for the Library for the year 1939 were read by the Recorder.

On motion the above claims were approved for payment. Yeas 8, nays 0.

Mr. Lent reported that the new settling tank and pumphouse was completed, also that the City was now buying power direct from the Bonneville Authority.

City Treasurer, John Eid, submitted his report for the fourth quarter and annual report for the year 1939. Motion was made, seconded and carried that Treasurer's report be accepted, subject to audit of the Finance Committee.

Fire Chief Kraft reported that the Dept. answered one call outside of town during the month, loss about \$50.00. Also stated that the new truck had arrived and that the Underwriters test would be made on the 6th.

Mr. Merle Wright and Mr. J. P. Telford, both, addressed the Council regarding <sup>INSURANCE ON</sup> City owned vehicles.

Motion was made, seconded and carried that the Committee on Public Property be authorized to take out insurance on City owned equipment.

After reading a copy of the call for bids, the Recorder proceeded to open seven bids that had been received on new pumping equipment. After some discussion, motion was made, seconded and carried that the bids be referred to the Water Committee and the Supt., for their recommendations and to call a special meeting at a later date to purchase the new pumping equipment.

Ordinance #323, providing rates for the consumers of electric current within the City of Canby came up for final action. On vote of the Council Ordinance # 323 was passed. Yeas 8, nays 0.
