

Special Meeting.
February 13, 1940.

A special meeting of the Council was held Tuesday February 13th., 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Chief of Police Hansen, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Everhart, Gesik, Koehler, Pfister, Porter, Reynolds and Stefani. Absent Atty. Zimmerman.

Mayor Vinyard announced that the meeting was called to consider bids on pumping equipment. Councilman Cutsforth stated that the Committee was in favor of the bid of the Fairbanks-Morse and Co., to furnish a pump and motor, as specified in the call for bids, for the sum of \$352.00.

After due consideration, motion was made, seconded and on vote of the Council carried, yeas 8-nays 0, that the bid of the Fairbanks-Morse & Co., be accepted.



Motion was made, seconded and carried that the new fire truck be accepted and a warrant for the amount of \$1,084.70 be drawn in favor of the Neep Equipment Co., in payment as approved at the regular January meeting of the Council.

Motion was made, seconded and carried that the Council approve the election of Christ Kraft, Jr. as Fire Chief for the year 1940.
