

Regular Meeting.
March 4, 1940.

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held Monday March 4th., 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Atty. Zimmerman Chief of Police Hansen, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Everhart, Gesik, Koehler, Porter, Reynolds and Stefani. Councilman Pfister absent.

Minutes of the regular February meeting and special meeting of February 13th. were read and approved.

A communication from Mr. N.B. Evans calling the Councils attention to the need of libiality insurance on City owned property and giving an outline of the rates was read by the Recorder.

On motion the above claims were approved for payment. Yeas 7, nays 0

Mr. Lent gave a comparative report on the new and old electric rates. Also stated that the Ray-Maling Co. had been inquiring about current.

After some discussion as to the number of rats about town, the Recorder was instructed to ask the State Agriculture Dept. if they could make some suggestions regarding rat control.

Councilman Stefani, reporting for Fire Chief Kraft, reported no fires during the month. That the forming of a new fire district was under way and that the fire dept. was contributing \$100.00 towards new equipment.

Councilman Koehler reported that the park lots had been leaveled. After discussion regarding the park lots, motion was made, seconded and carried that the Council call for bids on a five foot walk and five inch curbing around the park lots.

Councilman Reynolds reported on the insurance carried on the Fire truck. After due consideration motion was made, seconded and carried that insurance on the five pieces of equipment operated by the City, be placed with the American Casualty Co. thru their Agent Mr. Merle Wright. The amounts of these policies to be 10-20 thousand Public Libality and 5 thousand property damage.

Atty. Zimmerman reported of a complaint from Mrs. McFarland about an outside toilet on Mrs. Seaton's property. The City Atty. and Recorder was instructed to take the necessary action to abate.

There being no further business on motion the Council adjourned.
