

Regular Meeting.  
May 6, 1940.

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held Monday May 6th., 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Atty. Zimmerman, Chief of Police Hansen, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Everhart, Gesik, Koehler, Porter, Reynolds and Stefani. Absent Councilman Pfister.

Minutes of the regular April meeting and special meeting of April 5th. were read and approved.

Communications from the City of Portland and the League of Oregon Cities were read by the Recorder.

Mr. M.E. Wright, H.B. Evans and a Mr. Adkinson addressed the Council regarding liability insurance for the City. This matter was referred to the Committee and they were instructed to call a special meeting when ready to take action.

payment Finance plan. Motion was made, seconded and carried that the City of Canby make application to handle E.H. & F.A. Contracts.

Floyd Hall addressed the Council regarding inducements to be made to Manufacturers to locate their plants within Canby. Motion was made, seconded and carried that Mr. Kenneth Thompson be invited to talk to the Council on this matter.

Mr. Koehler asked how much street work the Council desired to have done this year. No action. After considerable discussion regarding the drainage gutter on Main St., motion was made, seconded and carried that the gutter be replaced with 12" pipe along Main St., between "B" & "C" Sts.

Motion was made, seconded and carried that a new drinking fountain be purchased and installed at the time of making the repairs on Main St.

City Treasurer, John Eid, read his report for the first quarter of 1940. The Treasurers report was accepted subject to audit of the Finance Committee.

Mayor Vinyard read a Telegram from Senator Holman, stating that the City of Canby's application for a W.P.A. project to extend the Water System, had been approved.

Ordinance #324, providing new rates for the consumers of water within the City of Canby, came up for final action. On vote of the Council Ordinance # 324 was passed. Yeas 6, nays 0.
