

Regular Meeting.  
July 1, 1940.

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held Monday July 1st., 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Atty. Zimmerman, Chief of Police Hansen, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Everhart, Gesik, Koehler, Porter, Reynolds and Stefani. Councilman Pfister absent.

Minutes of the regular June meeting were read and approved.

The following communications were read by the Recorder. A petition signed by residents along the Pacific Highway in the Northern part of town requesting the enlargement and extending of the water system in this part of town. A report from the Public Property Committee stating their findings regarding liability insurance.

On motion, seconded and carried the above claims were allowed.

Mr. Lent reported that the power lines along the highway had been taken over. That the new pump had been installed and was working fine. Recommended that a new 20 hp. motor be installed on the pump at the springs. Motion was made, seconded and carried that a new 20 hp. motor be purchased and installed on the springs pump, the old 15 hp. motor to be turned in on the purchase of the new motor.

Motion was made, seconded and carried that the Streets & Public Property Committee be authorized to purchase the winters supply of wood for the City Hall.

Lester Hess reported five graves opened during the month, half of a lot sold.

Ben Hansen requested a ten day vacation. Motion was made, seconded and carried that Ben Hansen be allowed a ten day vacation, the Police Committee to arrange for a substitute man.

Councilman Stefani reporting for Fire Chief Kraft stated the Fire Dept. answered two rural call during the month, also gave a report on the Firemans Convention.

Councilman Everhart requested that the City place some fire fighting equipment at the Fair Grounds during the Fair. This matter was left for future consideration.

City Treasurer John Eid gave a summary of his second quarter report.

Motion was made, seconded and carried that the petition regarding water extention along the Pacific Highway be referred to the Committee.

After considerable discussion regarding liability insurance, motion was made, seconded and carried that a ballot vote be taken to select the policy. After canvas of the vote the American Casualty Co. was

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awarded the policy covering liability insurance for the City.

Mr. Koehler reported the pipe for replacing the drain along Main St. had been purchased from the paper mill.

The Finance Committee was authorized to purchase the necessary record books for the Treasurer and Records office.

After due consideration Motion was made, seconded and carried, in the future price for grave openings be as follows:

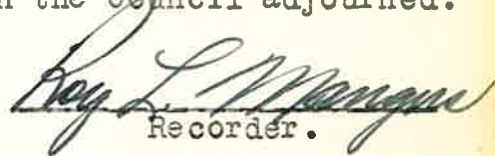
All charges payable cash in advance.
