The proposed levy was as follows:



On motion, seconded and on vote of the meeting carried, that 1940 Budget for the City of Canby be adopted as read.

A petition requesting that no property tax be levied by the City for the year 1940, that current expenses be paid out of the Light & Water collections was read by the Recorder. This being a special meeting the Council left this matter on the table for future consideration.

There being no further business on motion the Council adjourned.
