

Regular Meeting.  
October 2nd.1939.

The regluar monthly meeting of the Council was held Monday October 2nd., 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Atty. Zimmerman, Chief of Police Hansen, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Everhart, Gesik, Koehler and Pfister. Councilman Porter, Reynolds and Stefani reported later.

Minutes of the regular September meeting and special meeting of September 29th. were read and approved.

Motion was made, seconded, and on vote of the Council carried, Yeas 8, nays 0, that the above claims against the City be approved for payment.

Motion was made, seconded and carried that the logs that were left along "B" St. be removed to the City property.

The City Attorney was authorized to take the necessary action to abate the nuisance of objectionable outside toilets.

Motion was made, and seconded that the corrected bill of S.L. Beck & Son for \$34.75 be allowed. Motion carried yeas 8, nays 0.

City Treasurer John Eid read his report for the third quarter of 1939. Motion was made, seconded and carried that the Treasurer's report be accepted, subject to audit of the Finance Committee.

The Fire Committee was instructed to call for bids on a new fire truck chassis.

Councilman Porter recommended that proposed improvements in the water system be made this winter. The Water Committee was instructed to outline the improvements to be made and to report at the next meeting of the Council.

Motion was made seconded and carried that the Street Supt. purchase the necessary traffic signs and have same installed.

A petition requesting that no property tax be levied by the City for the year 1940, that current expenses be paid out of the Light & Water collections, was read by the Recorder. Motion was made, seconded and carried that this petition be left on the table.


Ordinance #320, levying a tax on all taxable property within the city limits of Canby was read by the Recorder. On vote of the Council ordinance #320 was passed on first reading and ordered published.

The Recorder was instructed to write the Highway Commission again, inquiring as to what action had been taken regarding lights on the Pacific Highway thru Canby.

There was some discussion regarding plans for the park lots, no action taken.

There being no further business on motion the Council adjourned.
