

Regular Meeting.  
December 4, 1939.

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held Monday December 4th. 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Chief of Police Hansen, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Everhart, Koehler, Pfister, Porter and Stefani. Councilman Gesik reported later. Atty. Zimmerman and Councilman Reynolds absent.

Minutes of the November meeting were read and approved.

Applications for retail beer license from Canby Inn and Cliff's Cafe, and a letter from T. Buggins, requesting a street light were read by the Recorder. Motion was made, seconded and carried that applications for retail beer license by Canby Inn and Cliff's cafe be approved. The letter of T. Buggins was referred to the light Committee.

The above claims were all approved for payment. Yeas 7, nays 0. Bill of \$144.00 by S.L. Beck & Son for perforating water pipe was referred to the Water Committee before payment.

Mr. Lent presented and explained a map of the proposed water system improvement. Motion was made, seconded and carried that the water system improvement be carried out as outlined.

Motion was made, seconded and carried that the Water Committee be authorized to purchase the necessary materials for the water system improvement.

Mr. Lent stated that a settling tank and pumphouse would be required at the new well. On motion that matter was referred to the Water Committee for necessary action.

Fire Chief Kraft reported that the new fire truck was nearing completion.

Mr. Koehler stated that the grader was ready for delivery.

Mr. Porter reported that plans were being drawn for the park.

Mr. Everhart reported that the work at the Cemetery was almost completed.

Ordinance # 321, authorizing the purchase of new fire fighting equipment was read by the Recorder. Motion was made, seconded and carried that ordinance # 321 be passed on first reading and ordered published.

Ordinance # 322, authorizing the purchase of a street grader was read by the Recorder. Motion was made, seconded and carried that ordinance # 322 be passed on first reading and ordered published.

The matter of insurance on all City owned vehicles was referred to the Committee.

Motion was made, seconded and carried that Mr. Koehler be authorized to move and repair the drinking fountain at the corner of "B" St.

There being no further business on motion the Council adjourned. Approved January 2, 1940.
