

Regular Meeting.  
February 6th.1939.

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held Monday February 6th. 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Atty. Zimmerman, Chief of Police Warnstaff, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Everhart, Gesik, Koehler, Reynolds and Stefani. Councilmen Pfister and Porter absent.

Minutes of the regular January meeting, adjourned meeting of January 6th. and Special meeting of January 16th. were read and approved.

Communications from W.O. Weiss, D.F. McKenzie and the League of Oregon Cities was read by the Recorder.

Motion was made, seconded and carried that the selection of Marshall be made by secret ballot. After a canvas of the votes cast Ben Hansen was appointed Marshall, and is to perform other duties as perscribed by the Council from time to time. For his services he is to receive \$70.00 per month.

On motion, seconded and carried the above claims were allowed. Yeas, 6-Nays 0.

Mr. Lent reported that he had been making some line and meter changes. The latourette springs were flowing about 225 gpm. and that filling time had been extended to June 1st. 1939.

Councilmen Everhart and Koehler reported that the City of Milwaukie maintains their traffic department and costs about \$125.00 per. month. This committee was instructed to continue their study of Canby's traffic problems.

Mayor Vinyard stated that he had a quit claim deed to the seven lots owned by Chas. N. Wait, and that there is \$556.00 taxes due on these lots. Also stated a deed was in the Bank for the three Cummings lots, awaiting \$300.00 payment for same. Motion was made, seconded and carried that the City purchase the three Cummings lots for \$300.00. Yeas 6, Nays 0.

Motion was made, seconded and carried that the City accept the gift of seven lots from Chas. N. Wait, and that an expression of thanks from the Council be sent him.

R.H. Reynolds reporting for Fire Chief Kraft stated the department answered two alarms during the month. Clair Haines home located outside of town was a total loss, the other call a flu fire, with no damage.

Councilman Koehler reported on the road work done, also removal of the bell tower. Also stated the instillation of three culverts was needed.

Ordinance M-2, Providing for the licensing and regulation of certain Professions, trades, and occupations within Canby came up for final action. On vote of the Council ordinance M-2 was passed. Yeas 6, Nays 0.
