

Special Meeting.
March 13, 1939.

A special meeting of the Council was held Monday March 13th. 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Atty. Zimmerman, Chief of Police Hansen, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Everhart, Gesik, Koehler, Pfister, Porter, Reynolds and Stefani.

Mayor Vinyard announced that the meeting was called to consider matters pertaining to the operation of the Cemetery.

The Recorder then read a recommendation to the Council, signed by Councilman Everhart, Chairman of the Cemetery Committee.


After considerable discussion, motion was made, seconded and carried that a call be made for bids for a Caretaker for the Cemetery. Bidder to sell lots, dig graves and do other work at rates set by the Council.

An Ordinance accepting seven lots, deeded to the City by Chas. N. Wait, the purchase of one lot from School District #86 for \$1.00, and the purchase of three lots from George R. and Bertha Cummings for \$300.00, all lots to be used to establish and maintain a City Park, was read by the Recorder. On motion, seconded and carried Ordinance was passed on first reading and ordered published.

An invitation was extended to the Clackamas County City Officials to meet in Canby as guests of the City Council, either March the 24th. or 31st. date to be decided later.

Councilman Gesik stated that he expected to attend the dog control meeting to be held in Oregon City March the 15th. , There being no further business ~~in~~ motion the Council adjourned.
