

Regular Meeting.
April 8, 1939.

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held Monday April 3rd., 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Atty. Zimmerman, Chief of Police Hansen, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Everhart, Gesik, Koehler, Porter, Reynolds and Stefani. Councilman Pfister reported later.

Minutes of the regular March meeting and Special meeting of March 13th. were read and approved.

On motion the above claims were allowed Yeas 8, Nays 0.

Mr. Lent stated that the Latourette springs had shown no increase in flow during the past month. The matter of water service for irrigation purposes was left with the water committee for consideration.

Mr. Hansen reported that a check had been made on the dogs in town.

Motion was made, seconded and carried to have new traffic tickets printed.

The Recorder was instructed to have the Treasurer's Bond changed from a continuous bond to a yearly bond.

Bids from Robert S. Funk, Oscar Weiss, George Zeek and Lester J. Hess for Cemetery Caretaker were opened and read by the Recorder.

On motion, seconded and carried all bids were rejected.

Motion was made, seconded and carried that R.W. Zimmerman be appointed Supt. of the Cemetery and to take care of the sale of lots, Ben Hansen to do the work of caretaking and grave opening.

Mayor Vinyard proclaimed the week of April 17th. to 20th. as Clean up week.

City Treasurer, John Eid read his report for the first quarter of 1939. Motion was made, seconded and carried that the Treasurer's report be accepted subject to audit of the Finance Committee.

The Fire Committee was instructed to report on the condition of the fire truck tires at the next meeting.

Councilman Porter recommended that the city purchase the necessary equipment to test electric meters. Motion was made and seconded that a meter tester be purchased. Motion carried.

Mr. Koehler stated that E.L. Rigdon would make the fill at the intersection of Maple St. & Market Road 10 for .70 per yard, and that about 20 yards would be needed. Motion was made, seconded and carried that Mr. Koehler have this fill made.

Mr. Koehler also stated that he could have Sixth St. graded within the next sixty days.

Motion was made, seconded and carried that a new flag be purchased for the City Hall.

The erection of a flag pole at the Cemetery was left with the Cemetery Committee for consideration.

Motion was made,seconded and carried that the Cemetery Committee be authorized to arrange for a Memorial service to be held at the Cemetery.

Motion was made,seconded and carried that Ben Hansen be instructed to repaint the fire hydrants.


Motion was made,seconded and carried that an audit be made of the City records.Arrangements for audit was left with the Finance Committee.


Ordinance # 318,acquiring eleven lots in block 14 to be used for park purposes was read by the Recorder.
