

Regular Meeting.  
May 1, 1939.

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held Monday May 1st. 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Atty. Zimmerman, Chief of Police Hansen, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Everhart, Gesik, Koehler, Reynolds and Stefani. Councilman Porter reported later, Councilman Pfister absent.

Minutes of the regular April meeting were read and approved.

Communications from Seely & Co. and the League of Oregon Cities were read by the Recorder.

On motion the above claims were allowed. Yeas 6, nays 0.

Councilman Reynolds reported for Fire Chief Kraft, stating three calls were answered during the month, two calls from outside of town and one from within the city limits.

Mr. Joe Stefani then addressed the Council, stating that the Fire Department expected to sponsor a float in the Portland Rose Festival parade and requested the City to contribute \$150.00 to be used toward building the float. Motion was made, seconded and on vote of the Council passed, yeas 7, nays 0, that an ordinance be drawn to contribute \$150.00 to the Volunteer Fire Department to be used toward a Rose Festival float.

Councilman Gesik stated that there had been some complaints made about outside toilets. This matter was referred to the Chief of Police to take the necessary action.

Councilman Everhart reported that a 40' steel flag pole, erected complete at the cemetery would cost \$35.00. Motion was made, seconded and carried that the Committee be authorized to purchase the flag pole and to have same erected before Memorial Day.

Ordinance #319, fixing the compensation of the Superintendent of the Water Works and defining his duties, was read by the Recorder. On vote of the Council ordinance #319 was passed on first reading and ordered published.

Motion was made, seconded and carried that the City Treasurer be authorized to apply for an extension on the Frye Investment Co. bond held by the City.

Councilman Porter reported that the cost of changing the tires and tubes on the fire truck would be about \$125.00 to \$150.00. Motion was made, seconded and carried that new tires and tubes be purchased for the fire truck.

Mayor Vinyard announced that a special meeting of the Council would be held Wednesday night May 3rd.

There being no further business on motion the Council adjourned.
