

Regular Meeting.  
June 5, 1939.

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held Monday June 5th. 1939. 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Atty. Zimmerman, Chief of Police Hansen, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Everhart, Koehler, Pfister, Porter and Stefani. Absent Councilmen Gesik and Reynolds.

Minutes of the regular May meeting and special meeting of May 3rd. were read and approved.

A communication from the U.S. Dept. of the Interior was read.

After being introduced by Melvin Evans, Mr. Hodge of the Portland General Electric Co. addressed the Council offering a water heater rate of six mills per KWH. This matter was referred to the Committee and Mr. Lent.

On motion, seconded and carried the above claims were allowed. yeas 6, nays 0.

Report of the audit made by J.L. Eckerson was read by the Recorder.

Councilman Everhart stated that he approved of the recommendations as set forth in the Auditors report, in regard to a change in the record system now in use. The Finance Committee and Mr. Lent were instructed to meet with the Auditor and consider his recommendations. The Auditors report was then referred to the Finance Committee for approval.

Mr. Koehler reported that the park lots had been spring weeded. Also recommended that the repair of streets be postponed for a year.

Motion was made and seconded that the Street Committee be instructed to look at a used grader and if found satisfactory, authorized to purchase same. Motion carried.

Motion was made, seconded and carried that oiling of the streets that a special tax was voted for, be referred to the street Committee.

Motion was made and seconded that the Treasurer's Bond submitted by J.L. Eckerson be accepted. Motion carried.

Ordinance #319, fixing the compensation of the Superintendent of the water works and defining his duties, came up for final action. On vote of the Council Ordinance #319 was passed. Yeas 6, nays 0.

Mr. Everhart reported the estimated cost of pipe for extending the water system at the cemetery would be about \$900.00, no estimate made for labor.

Motion was made, seconded and carried that a letter of thanks be sent to all participating in the Memorial Day services held at the cemetery.

There being no further business, on motion the Council adjourned.
