

Regular Meeting.
July 3rd.1939.

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held Monday July 3rd., 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Atty. Zimmerman, Chief of Police Hansen, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Everhart, Gesik, Koehler, and Porter. Councilmen Pfister and Stefani reported later, Reynolds absent.

Minutes of the regular June meeting were read and approved.

Communications from Thomas & Telford and City Attorney Ralph C. Zimmerman were read by the Recorder. A copy of the State Act governing the deposit of Municipal funds was also read. Mr Eid, City Treasurer, then explained the method used for handling City Funds. After discussion, the matter of placing a part of the City funds on time deposit was left with the Finance Committee for consideration.


Mr. S.L. Beck was present and discussed with the Council the matter of drilling a test well. Motion was made, seconded and carried that the call for bids and drilling of a test well be left with the Water Committee.

Councilman Everhart presented for the Councils consideration the matter of taking a percentage of the Light & Water receipts for general operating expenses, and abolishing the City Tax levy altogether. This matter was left on the table for consideration.

The Recorder was instructed to write the Highway Commission in regard to traffic controll on the Pacific Highway, also the Southern Pacific Co about the condition of the "C" St. crossing.

There being no further business, on motion the Council adjourned.
