

Special Meeting.
July 24, 1939.


A special meeting of the Council was held Monday July 24th. 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Chief of Police Hansen, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Everhart, Gesik, Koehler, Pfister, Porter, Reynolds & Stefani. Atty. Zimmerman absent.

Mayor Vinyard announced that the meeting was called to open and consider the bids for drilling a test well. Whereupon bids from the following well drillers was opened and read. S.L. Beck & Son, and Peter Hornig of Canby, and B.F. Ballweber, Woodburn, Oregon. After considering the various bids, motion was made, seconded and on vote of the Council passed, that the contract for drilling a test well be awarded to S.L. Beck & Son. The Water Committee was instructed to select the well location.

Motion was made, seconded and carried that the Cemetery Committee be authorized to purchase and install a water tank, and to have approximately 184 ft. of 4 inch water pipe laid, at the Cemetery.

There being no further business on motion the Council adjourned.
