

Regular Meeting.
August 7, 1939.

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held Monday August 7th., 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Atty. Zimmerman, Chief of Police Hansen, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Gesik, Koehler, Porter, Stefani & Pfister. Absent Councilmen Everhart and Reynolds.

Minutes of the regular July meeting and special meeting of July 24th. were read and approved.

Communications from the State Ind. Acc. Comm., Southern Pacific Co., and the Rothenberg Family were read by the Recorder. The Recorder also reported on the cost of infected earwigs. Motion was made, seconded and carried that 1000 Earwig be purchased.

On motion, seconded and carried the above claims were allowed. Yeas 6, nays 0.

Mr. Mueller addressed the Council calling attention to the fire hazard existing at the City dump. Motion was made, seconded and carried that the Health & Police Committee be authorized to make necessary arrangements to control and eliminate the hazards at the city dump.

Motion was made, seconded and carried that the Water Committee be authorized to proceed with the new well, making the necessary purchases and connections, providing the tests prove satisfactory.

Motion was made and seconded that \$200.00 be advanced to S. L. Beck & Son, on well drilling. Vote on motion was yeas 6, nays 0.

Fire Chief Kraft stated the Fire Dept. answered six calls during the month, two of the calls being within town, no damage.

The matter of the nightwatchmans vacation was left with the Comm.

The Finance Committee reported approval of the Treasurer's report for the second quarter of 1939.

Motion was made, seconded and carried that the Mayor appoint a Budget Committee. Mayor Vinyard then named the following persons to serve on the Budget Committee: George F. Bates, W. Sandsness, George Cattley, E. A. Krueger, John Koehler, Peter Kylo, Craig Dedman and E. C. Shull.

There was some discussion regarding the purchase of additional fire fighting equipment. No action taken.

There being no further business on motion the Council adjourned.
