

Special Meeting.
August 28, 1939.

A Special meeting of the Council was held Monday August 28th., 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Chief of Police Hansen, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Everhart, Pfister, Porter and Stefani. Absent Councilmen Gesik, Koehler and Reynolds and Attorney Zimmerman.

Mayor Vinyard announced that the meeting was called to open and consider bids for drilling a new well. Whereupon the Recorder proceeded to open the only bid received, that being one from S.L. Beck & Son, offering to dig a 10" well for \$5.25 per foot, a 12" well for \$6.50 per foot not to exceed 200 feet. After due discussion motion was made, and seconded that a contract be given to S.L. Beck & Son to drill a 12" well at \$6.50 per foot. On vote of the Council motion carried. Yeas 5, nays 0.

Fire Chief Kraft reported on the estimated cost of an additional fire truck.

There being no further business on motion the Council adjourned
