

Regular Meeting.
September 5, 1939.

Motion was made, seconded and carried that the Fire Chief be authorized to attend the sale to be held by the Portland Fire Dept. and to purchase what equipment he thinks suitable for the Canby Fire Dept.

There being no further business, on motion the Council adjourned.
