

Regular Meeting.
October 3rd. 1938.

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held Monday October 3rd. 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Atty. Zimmerman, Chief of Police Warnstaff, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Gesik, Koehler, Pfister, Porter, Rothenberg and Thompson. Councilman Everhart absent.

Minutes of the regular September meeting and special meeting of September 30th. were read and approved.

Communications from the Oregon Fire Chief's Assoc. and the League of Oregon Cities was read by the Recorder.

On motion, seconded and carried the above claims were allowed. Yeas 7, nays 0.

Mr. Lent recommended that rates be established for electric water heaters, also stated, one of the Latourette springs was dry, the other flowing about 318 gpm.

Chief of Police Warnstaff recommended the placing of a STOP sign at the intersection of "A" & Main Sts.

City Treasurer, John Eid read his report for the third quarter. Motion was made, seconded and carried that the Treasurer's report be accepted subject to audit of the Finance Committee.

Ordinance #299, providing for the erection of vehicular Safety and Stop signs, came up for final action. On vote of the Council Ordinance #299 was passed. Yeas 7, nays 0.

Ordinance #300, levying a tax on all taxable property within the City limits of Canby was read by the Recorder. On vote of the Council Ordinance # 300 was passed on first reading and ordered published.

Motion was made, seconded and carried that the street running from Weed St. to the old Pacific Highway, passing north of the High School property, be named Knight St.

The franchise submitted by the Portland General Electric Co. was referred to the City Attorney for revision.

Fire Chief Kraft gave a report of the Fireman's Convention at Pendleton, also stated that there were no calls during the month.

There being no further business, on motion the Council adjourned.
