

Special Meeting.
December 12, 1938.

A special meeting of the Council was held Monday December 12th. 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Atty. Zimmerman, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Koehler, Porter, Rotherberg and Thompson. Absent Councilmen Everhart, Gesik & Pfister.

Recorder Mangus stated that he had priced used typewriters and desks. A suitable typewriter with extra wide carriage would be \$35.00 and a desk \$40.00. Motion was made, seconded and carried, that the Recorder be authorized to purchase a desk and typewriter.
