Fred Larson stated the Fire Dept.had erected the Xmas.Tree and also had given aid to some needy families about town.

Ordinance #89,permitting the operation and playing of pin-ball games in Canby,was then discussed.Motion was made and seconded that Ordinance #89 be taken off the table for consideration.Upon vote of the Council a tie vote of 4 and 4 resulted,Mayor Vinyard cast the deciding vote in favor of motion to consider Ordinance #89.Ordinance #89 was then read by the Recorder.A number of persons present addressed the Council both for and against the final passage of Ordinance #89. After consideration,motion was made and seconded that Ordinance #89 be placed on the table.On vote of the Council motion carried.

Ordinance #91 authorizing the payment of \$150.00 to Robison, Scott & Scott for sidewalk construction,came up for final action.On vote of the Council Ordinance #91 was passed.Yeas 8,Nays 0.

Mayor Vinyard stated that there would be a meeting of the Council Monday evening Jan.10th.to consider Cemetery matters.

There being no further business,on motion the Council adjourned.
