Regular Meeting. March 7th.1938.

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held Monday March 7th.8 o'clock P.M.On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Chief of Police Rothenberg, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Everhart, Gesik, Roehler, Porter and Rothenberg. Absent Atty. Wait and Councilmen Pfister and Thompson.

Minutes of the regular February meeting were read and approved. The following communications were read by the Recorder Letters from League of Oregon Cities, A.F. Knight, Lester Hess and an application for beer license by A.W.Russell.

On motion, seconded and carried the above claims were allowed. yeas, 6-nays 0.

Mr.McKenzie of Oregon City addressed the council in regard to patch work on the streets. He offered to furnish 7 men, 2 gravel trucks and one oiler for \$9.25 per hour. This matter was left with the Committee on streets for consideration.

Mr.Lent made the following recommendations and reports. That the ditch in front of Mrs. Coons meeded some attention, that the electric moter at the cemetery had been burned out. New light bill forms were needed. He estimated the total cost of the pipeline to the Fairgrounds at \$1,300.00, to the Church \$565.00. The Committee was instructed to get in touch with John Telford and to arrange a meeting with the County Court for further consideration.

Motion was made and seconded that the City file for water rights on the water from the Latourette springs. Motion carried. Fire Chief Kraft reported that the new fire hose had been

received.

Mr.Rothenberg reported that the Treasurer's report for the fourth quarter of 1937 had been approved.

The Recorder was instructed to notify Mr.A.F.Knight, that due

to price, the city would not consider further the purchase of

his property.
Ordinance #92, fixing the rates to be charged the users of electric light, power and heat furnished by the electric light and power system of Canby came up for final action. On vote of the Council Ordinance #92 was passed. Yeas 6, nays 0.

Ordinance #93, ratifying a contract with the B.F. Goodrich Co. for the purchase of fire hose and appropriating \$665.00 out of the General Fund for payment thereof, was introduced. On vote of the Council was passed on first reading and ordered published. M Motion was made and seconded that the application for Beer License of A.W.Russell be approved.Motion carried.

Motion was made, seconded and carried that the house and a garden spot on the Cemetery property be leased to Lester Hess, for \$10.00 per month. Selection of a caretaker for the Cemetery

was left with the Committee. The Recorder was instructed to get in touch with Ray Fish requesting an offer from him for the Cities lot that adjoins his property.

There being no further business, on motion the Council adjourned.
