

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held Monday April 4th. 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Chief of Police Rothenberg, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Everhart, Koehler, Pfister, Porter, Rothenberg and Thompson. Absent Attorney Wait and Councilman Gesik.

Minutes of the Regular March meeting were read and approved.

The resignation of Mr. Rothenberg as Chief of Police, effective May 1st. was read by the Recorder.

Motion was made and seconded that the above bills be allowed, bill of D.F. McKenzie for street work be paid when presented with the approval of Councilman Koehler. Motion carried. Yeas 7, Nays 0

Mayor Vinyard then proclaimed the week of April 18th. to 23rd. as Clean-up week.

Motion was made and seconded that the Recorder be given the power to make adjustments in Cemetery rates. Motion carried.

Motion was made and seconded that Mr. Everhart be authorized to take care of the Cemetery and to sell lots. Motion carried.

The Recorder was instructed to have the electricity turned on at the Cemetery.

Moving of the bell tower from the old city hall lot was left with the Committee to take care of.

City Treasurer John Eid read his annual report for the year 1937, and quarterly report for the first quarter of 1938.

Motion was made, seconded and carried that the Treasurer's report be accepted, subject to audit of the Finance Committee.

Motion was made, seconded and carried that Mr. Rothenberg's resignation as Chief of Police be accepted as of May 1st. Mayor Vinyard and members of the Council expressed their thanks and appreciation to Mr. Rothenberg for the excellent manner in which he has served the City, as Chief of Police.

Ordinance #93, ratifying a contract with the B.F. Goodrich Co. for the purchase of fire hose and appropriating \$665.00 out of the General Fund thereof, came up for final action. On vote of the Council Ordinance #93 was passed yeas 7, Nays 0.

There being no further business on motion the Council adjourned.
