A letter from the Clackamas County Planning Board, Beer license application from Florence Marks, Check for \$15.00 from the National Bondholders Corp. interest on bonds, a letter from Fred Schwab Commission Co. with a check for \$19.36 enclosed, and an application from Claude H. McNamee for appointment as Chief of Police.

The Recorder was instructed to get a list of the bonds and other funds that were turned over to the City by the Zion Cemetery Association.

Motion was made, seconded and carried the the beer license application of Florence Marks be approved.

Motion was made seconded and carried that the water committee be instructed to call for bids on new roof and other repairs on the pumphouse and to report on same at the next meeting.

There being no further business on motion the Council adjourned.
