

A special meeting of the Council was held Monday May 23rd. 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Chief of Police Warnstaff, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Koehler, Pfister, Porter, Rothenberg and Thompson. Absent Atty. Wait and Councilmen Everhart and Gesik.


Mayor Vinyard announced that the meeting had been called to consider making an application to the Bonneville project Administrator for electric power, as soon as same is available. The Recorder then read a letter addressed to Mr. J.D. Ross, Administrator, stating that the City of Canby was now ready to sign a contract for electric power at the announced rate of \$17.50 per kilowatt year.

After due discussion motion was made and seconded that the electric light Sup^t., Mayor and Recorder be authorized to sign the letter to Mr. J.D. Ross. On vote of the Council motion was unanimously passed.

Mr. Lent was instructed to install new coils in the drinking fountain at the corner of Main and "B" sts.

There being no further business on motion the Council adjourned.
