Mr.Lent reported that he had filed for water rights on the Latourette springs and that the estimated flow was about 1,000 gallons per minute.He also recommended that some action be taken to provide for irrigation.Also recommended that a 6 inch main extension be made to the Wicker corner,cost to be about \$750.00. Motion was made,seconded and carried that the 6inch main be extended to the Wicker corner.Location and selection of hydrants to be left with the Committee.

The Cemetery Committee was instructed to tag all the water outlets at the Cemetery warning not to use the water for drinking purposes.

Fire Chief Kraft reported one fire alarm answered,Recommended the purchase of additional hose for the booster tank.

The Recorder reported the following was turned over by the Zion Cemetery Association to the Cemetery Fund.Frye Investment Co. Bond \$500.00-National Bondholders Corp. \$500.00-Cash \$2,436.37

Was agreed that the Council would meet at the springs Tuesday night,June 7th.6:30 P.M.

There being a number of Councilmen and Mayors present from Oswego,Molalla and Milwaukie present,Mayor Vinyard greeted them with a few words of welcome after which the meeting was devoted to discussing various subject that the Cities have to deal with.

There being no further business on motion the Council adjourned.
