A special meeting of the Council was held Wednesday June 22nd. 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Chief of Police Warnstaff, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Gesik, Pfister, Porter, Rothenberg and Thompson. Absent Atty. Wait, Councilmen Everhart and Koehler.

Mayor Vinyard announced that the meeting had been called to take up with Judge Earl C. Latourette, who was present, the matter of an option on the property, east of Canby, that has been considered by the Council.

After due discussion Mr. Latourette advised the Council to adopt a Resolution to take an option on the springs and surrounding property. Was decided that this would be left to the next regular meeting.

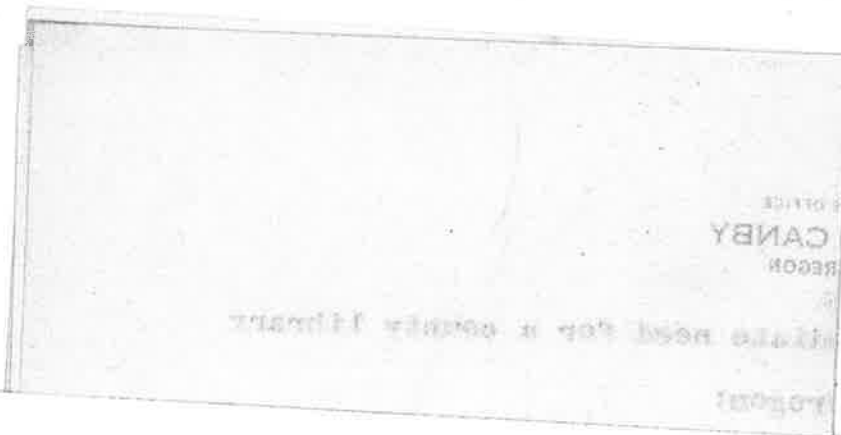

AND WHEREAS, each city in the County of Clackamas is now maintaining a public library;



BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Canby that we go on record as favoring a county public library:


