Motion was made and seconded that the Recorder be allowed \$60.00 per year for additional work of keeping the Cemetery records. On vote of the Council motion passed, yeas 7, nays 0.

Motion was made and seconded that an option be taken on the Latourette Estate property at \$5,000.00 for the four tracts, consisting of approximately 20 acres, on vote of the Council was unamiously approved.

The Committee was instructed to call for bids for a new roof on the pump house, with various kinds of shingles to be considered.

The Fire Chief was instructed to check up on all grass fire hazards about town.

The Cemetery Committee was authorized to have the necessary maps made and to list all the old graves possible at the Cemetery.

The matter of repairs to the house and chicken house at the Cemetery was left with the Committee.
