Motion was made and seconded that letting of bids be left until the regular August meeting and that Mr. Lamb and Mr. Koehler be requested to be present at that time. Motion carried.

The matter of installing street sighs was left with the

Committee for recommendations.

A letter was read by the Recorder from the League of Oregon Cities stating that they were ready to start the compilation of the Ordinances of the City of Canby. Whereupon a motion was made, seconded and carried that the Recorder be authorized to send to the League of Oregon Cities all records so that the compilation could be made.

There being no further business on motion the Council adjourned.
