

The Regular monthly meeting of the Council was held Monday June 7th. 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Atty. Wait, Chief of Police Rothenberg, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Everhart, Gesik, Koehler, Porter, Pfister Rothenberg and Thompson.

Minutes of the last regular meeting were read and approved.

Communications from Earl Snell, Bates, Lively & Pearson, Thomas & Telford, State Fire Marshall and Elwood Fiast were read by the Recorder. Two petitions requesting that streets be oiled were also read by the Recorder.

Was moved and seconded that the insurance policy on the new fire truck be renewed. On vote of the Council motion carried.

Motion was made and seconded that the Recorder be instructed to return the fire insurance policy on the new City Hall to the Contractors. Motion carried.

Earnest Kloehe and C.F. Crocker addressed the Council in regard to the paving of streets. After due discussion motion was made and seconded that this matter be referred to the Committee on Streets for recommendations and estimates and to report back to the Council. Motion carried.

Mrs. C.P. Shewey then addressed the Council requesting their help in obtaining a permanent library for Canby. She stated that W.P.A. is establishing several Libraries about the County and in each case the Librarian is Paid from W.P.A. funds, the community to furnish light head and space. After some discussion motion was made and seconded that the City furnish light, fuel and space for a W.P.A. Library. Motion carried.

On motion, seconded and carried the above claims were allowed. yeas 8, nays 0.

Ordinance #83 was then read by the Recorder. On motion, seconded and carried Ordinance #83 was passed on first reading and ordered published.

Ordinance #84 was then read by the Recorder. On motion, seconded and carried Ordinance #84 was passed on first reading and ordered published.

Fred Larson reporting for Fire Chief Kraft stated the Department answered one call during the month, one house was burned but the department saved a barn and other buildings.

Mr. Lent gave estimates of cost of water main extension back of the Shell station. Also requested the Councils permission to take one week of his vacation the week of June 14th. This request was granted.

Mr. John Koehler stated money and other assets of the Cemetery Association had been placed with the Bank and were ready to be turned over to the City.

The Committee was instructed to call for bids on Fire tower.  
There being no further business on motion the Council adjourned.
