

A Special meeting of the Council was held Monday August 9th. 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Attorney Wait, Chief of Police Rothenberg, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Everhart, Gesik, Koehler, Pfister and Rothenberg. Councilmen Cutsforth, Porter and Thompson absent.

Mayor Vinyard called the Council to order and announced that the meeting was called to take care of Cemetery matters.

Councilman Everhart gave a report of the work being done at the Cemetery, rubbish cleaned up, trees being topped, hedge taken out to the walk, and survey had been made of the grounds and new lots laid out. Mr. Koehler recommended the use of a bulldozer for leveling. The Mayor instructed the Committee to use their judgement in this matter.

Mr. Everhart recommended that a file card and ledger record system be used.

A letter to Mr. Everhart, from the Riverside Cemetery Assoc., Albany, Oregon giving information as to the operation of their Cemetery was read by the Recorder.

Lester Hess addressed the Council in regard to the Sextons job at the Cemetery.

Mr. Koehler stated that the Knight Bridge road would have to be graded and graveled this fall.

A letter from Krueger Bros. stating that they were going to construct a new building on the corner of "D" and Main Sts. and asking a permit to use the street during construction was read by the Recorder. On motion, seconded and carried permit was granted.

There being no further business on motion the Council adjourned.
