

A Special meeting of the Council was held Monday Sept. 27, 1937 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinvard, Attorney Wait, Chief of Police Rothenberg, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Gesik, Koehler, Pfister, Porter and Rothenberg. Absent Councilmen Cutsforth, Everhart and Thompson.

Mayor Vinvard stated that the meeting had been called to consider and adopt a Budget for the coming year. The proposed levy as submitted by the Budget Committee was read as follows:

After due consideration motion was made and seconded that the levy for City Marshall be raised to \$240.00. Motion Carried.

Motion was made and seconded that the levy for Night Watchmen be raised to \$ 1080.00, motion carried.

Motion was made and seconded that the balance of the Budget be accepted as submitted by the Budget Committee. Motion carried.

There was some discussion as to making a special levy for street improvement work. This was left with the Committee on Streets.

There being no further business, on motion the Council adjourned.
