the old City Hall building be accepted. Motion carried.

Motion was made and seconded that John Stefani be given the contract to build the Fire Hose tower on the City Hall for \$475.00. On vote of the Council, metion carried. Yeas 7, nays 9.

Mr. John Koehler addressed the Council, stating that he expected to rereef his building and asked to have the sirene removed. Mr. Kraft stated that the Fire Dept. would take care of moving the sirene.

Ordinance #87, regulating the use of bicycles within the City Limits of Canby, then came up for final action. On motion seconded, and carried was duly declaired passed. Yeas 7, nays 0.

Ordinance #88, levying a tax on all property, both real and personal for the year 1938 was read by the Recorder. On motion, seconded and carried, ordinance #88 was passed on first reading and ordered published.

City Treasurer, John Eid then read his report for the third quarter. On metion, seconded and carried the Treasurers report was accepted, subject to approval of the Finance Committee.

There being no further business, on motion the Council adjourned.
