Ordinance #88, levying a tax on all taxable property, came up for final action. On motion, seconded and carried was passed. Yeas 8, mays 0. Ordinance #90, approperating \$495.00 to pay John Stefani for the construction of hose tower on the City Hall, was introduced. On vote of the Council was passed on first reading and ordered published.

The matter of moving the bell tower from the old City Hall

property was left in the hands of the Committee.

There being no further business on motion the Council adjourned.
