

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held Monday November 1st. 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Attorney Wait, Chief of Police Rothenberg, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Everhart, Koehler, Pfister, Porter, Rothenberg and Thompson. Councilman Gesik reported later.

Minutes of the regular October meeting were read and approved.

Mr. C.C. Marks addressed the Council, requesting that some action be taken in regard to the operation of pin-ball games. Mr. Gould also addressed the Council on this matter. After some discussion Ordinance #89, permitting the operation and playing of pin-ball games in Canby, was introduced. On vote of the Council ordinance was declared passed on first reading and ordered published.

Mr. M.J. Lee then presented to the Council for their consideration some surveying instruments that he had for sale. Was decided that the City had no need for these.

Elwood Fiast then addressed the Council in regard to renting the unused Cemetery ground. This matter was left in the hands of the Cemetery Committee to work out an agreement.

The Recorder was instructed to have the electricity turned off at the Cemetery.

On motion, seconded and carried the above claims were allowed. Yeas 8, Nays 0.

The Finance Committee reported the approval of the Treasurers report for the third quarter.

Mr. Koehler stated that 99 yards of gravel had been used on the Amerine road, and that one more load would be needed.

Mr. Lent reported 4 new light and 2 new water connections made, also stated that a transformer had been burned out during the month.

Ordinance #88, levying a tax on all taxable property, came up for final action. On motion, seconded and carried was passed. Yeas 8, Nays 0.

Ordinance #90, appropriating \$495.00 to pay John Stefani for the construction of hose tower on the City Hall, was introduced. On vote of the Council was passed on first reading and ordered published.

The matter of moving the bell tower from the old City Hall property was left in the hands of the Committee.

There being no further business on motion the Council adjourned.
