

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held Monday March 1, 1937. 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Atty. Wait, Chief of Police Rothenberg, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Everhart, Koehler, Pfister, Porter, Rothenberg and Thompson. Councilman Gesik reported later.

Minutes of the regular February meeting and Special meeting of February 8th. were read and approved.

Communications from Oregon State Board of Health, Oregon State Highway Commission, League of Oregon Cities and the Canby Volunteer Fire Dept. were read by the Recorder.

After some discussion was decided that the \$500.00 insurance now carried on the old City Hall is enough.

Motion was made and seconded that Dr. E. A. Hendry be appointed as Registrar and Health Officer for the City. Motion carried.

On motion, seconded and carried the above claims were allowed. Yeas 8 Nays 0.

Mr. Cutsforth stated he had received complaints regarding outdoor toilets. This matter was referred to the Health Committee.

Fred Larson reporting for Fire Chief Kraft stated the Fire Department answered one alarm during the month. Cause of the fire was a defective chimney, damage amounted to about \$350.00 which was covered by insurance.

Mr. Lent reported two new light and water connections made during the month, also light was installed at the highway intersection.

After some discussion motion was made and seconded that Robison, Scott & Scott be given the job of laying an eight foot sidewalk and drive to the jail entrance of the new City Hall.


Motion was made and seconded that the Committee on Fire and Water be authorized to get prices on sirenes and report at the next meeting.
