

A Special Meeting of the Council was held at the New City Hall Tuesday March 23rd. 2 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Atty. Wait, Chief of Police Rothenberg, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Gesik, Koehler, Porter and Rothenberg. Councilmen Everhart, Pfister and Thompson absent.

Mayor Vinyard call the meeting to order and stated the meeting was called to inspect the building and to accept or reject same.

Mr. John Koehler stated the building was completed as per specifications.

After inspecting the building Mayor Vinyard read the following Resolution.

RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, FEDERAL EMERGENCY ADMINISTRATION OF PUBLIC WORKS, and Robinson, Scott & Scott, Contractors, have fully completed their contract to build a City Hall for the City of Canby, Oregon, said contract being of the date of October 10th. 1936.


We the City Council of Canby, Oregon, having inspected said City Hall Building, upon the statement of said Contractors that said City Hall Building was now completed, and that the said Contractors had entirely fulfilled their contract in regard thereto, and were at this time ready to turn said building over to the City of Canby as completed according to contract; and the said City Council of Canby having inspected said Building, and having found it completed as specified in said contract;

HEREBY RESOLVE, that said building be and hereby is accepted as completed by the Contractorsthereto; and discharge said Contractors from further liability and obligation therein.

Councilman George Koehler made a motion that Resolution be passed, seconded by Councilman Rothenberg. On vote of the Council Resolution was passed. Yeas 5, Nays 0.

There being no further business on motion the Council adjourned.
