

A special meeting of the Council was held Friday October 2nd. 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Atty. Wait, Chief of Police Rothenberg, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Bates, Cutsforth, Giger, Hornig, Porter, Rothenberg and Thompson. Councilman Koehler absent.

Mayor Vinyard stated the meeting had been called to consider and adopt a Budget for the year 1937. Whereupon the proposed levy as submitted by the Budget Committee was read as follows:

After some discussion, and with the consent of the members of the Budget Committee that were present: motion was made and seconded that the sum of \$175.00 be added to the Road Fund,

Motion was made and seconded, that Budget be accepted as amended and the City Attorney be instructed to draw an Ordinance to be presented at the next meeting of the Council. On vote of the Council, motion was declared passed.

Mr. Thompson then stated the sidewalk between "A" & "C" Sts. on the east side of the highway was in an unsafe condition for use after dark. The Recorder was instructed to take this matter up with the State Highway Department as this walk is on their property.

There being no further business, on motion the Council adjourned.
