

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held Monday June 1st. 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Atty. Wait, Chief of Police Rothenberg, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Bates, Cutsforth, Giger, Hornig, Rothenberg and Thompson. Councilman Porter, reported later, Councilman Koehler, absent.

Minutes of the last regular meeting were read and approved.

The Recorder read a bid submitted by Chas. Thomas for digging and backfilling approximately 1800 feet of water main ditch, at \$1.59 per rod for 36 inch, and \$1.44 per rod for 30 inch ditch.

Motion was made and seconded that bid of Chas. Thomas for digging 1800 feet, more or less, be accepted. Motion carried.
