

A special meeting of the City Council of Canby, Oregon, held pursuant to the preceding call of the Mayor, was held on the 28th. day of August 1936.

The meeting was called to order by the Mayor and on roll call the following answered present: Mayor Vinyard, City Attorney Wait, Chief of Police Rothenberg, City Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Bates, Hornig, Koehler, Porter, Rothenberg and Thompson.

The following were absent: Councilmen Cutsforth and Giger.

After discussion of the offer of the United States of America to aid by way of grant in financing the construction of a City hall and firehouse the following Resolution, numbered 2-1936, and entitled "A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE OFFER OF THE UNITED STATES TO THE CITY OF CANBY, OREGON TO AID BY WAY OF GRANT IN FINANCING THE CONSTRUCTION OF CITY HALL AND FIRE HOUSE", was proposed by Councilman George F. Bates, and read in full:

RESOLUTION No.2-1936.

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE OFFER OF THE UNITED STATES TO THE CITY OF CANBY, OREGON TO AID BY WAY OF GRANT IN FINANCING THE CONSTRUCTION OF CITY HALL AND FIRE HOUSE.

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Canby, Oregon

Section 1. That the offer of the United States of America to the City of Canby, Oregon to aid by way of grant in financing the construction of City hall and fire house, a copy of which reads as follows:

Subject to the Rules and Regulations (PWA Form No. 179, as amended to date) which are made a part hereof, the United States of America hereby offers to aid in financing the construction and equipping of a city hall building (herein called the "Project") by making a grant to the City of Canby in the amount of 45 percent of the cost of the Project upon completion, as determined by the Federal Emergency Administrator of Public Works, but not to exceed, the sum of \$5,318.

"It is hereby covenanted that work on the project described in the offer will be commenced by October 1, 1936; that the work will be planned so that it will reach a substantial peak before January 1, 1937 and that the project will be completed by October 1, 1937."

Section 2. That said City of Canby agrees to abide by all the rules and regulations relating to such grant a copy of which rules and regulations were annexed to the Government's offer and made a part thereof.

Section 3. That the City Recorder be and he is hereby authorized and directed forthwith to send to the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works three certified copies of this Resolution and three certified copies of the proceedings of this special meeting in connection with the adoption of this Resolution, and such further documents or proofs in connection with the acceptance of said offer as may be requested by the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works.
