On motion, seconded and carried the above claims were allowed. Yeas 6-nays 0.

Fire Chief Larson reported there were no fires in town during the month, and the department burned grass off of eleven pieces of property around town. Also stated the department took second prize at the Territorial Days celebration in Oregon City.

Mr. Hornig recommended that larger lights be placed around the High School. After some discussion motion was made and seconded that two more lights be installed on the line in front of the High School. On vote of the Council motion passed and the Light Committee was instructed to work with the Light Superintendent on the installation.

The Committee on Streets and Public Property was instructed to look over sidewalks and to post "Notice of repair" where walks were found in bad condition, they were also instructed to inspect the red barn across from the Methodist Church.

Ordinance #77 then came up for final action. On motion, seconded and carried was declared passed. Yeas 6-Nays 0.

Mayor Vinyard then appointed the following as members of the Budget Committee, Ed. Krueger, W. Sandsness, B.P. Pfister, A.S. Markee, George Cattley, Horace Patch, G.W. White, and John Koehler.

Mr. Lent was granted his usual vacation of two weeks.

There being no further business, on motion the Council adjourned.
