On motion, seconded and carried the above claims were allowed. Yeas 8, nays 0.

Mr. Owen of the Associated Service Station addressed the Council requesting the extension of the water line to his service station. This extension and permit for same from the State Highway Commission were left to the Committee to be reported on later.

Reports.

City Treasurer, Mr. John Eid made his quarterly report ending Sept. 30th. 1935. This was referred to the Finance Committee.

Fire Chief Larson reported the Fire Department had answered four calls, three incurring no loss and one an estimated loss of \$75 to \$100.00

Mr. Bates reported the water extension beyond High School could best be done next Spring and estimated cost to be from \$350. to \$450.00

Mr. Koehler suggested that the street in front of the Funeral Home be graveled. On motion, seconded and carried the Street Committee was given the authority to fix the street as they see fit.

Mr. Rothenberg stated he had investigated the open toilets and found one in bad condition, but had a promise that this would be fixed.

The Recorder was instructed to request by letter The Shell Oil Co. and W.R. Telford to extend the sidewalk along their property on "C" St.

On motion, seconded and carried the Mayor was authorized to appoint sufficient Firemen as Special Police to act in case of fire, fire prevention and emergencies.

Ordinance #74 then came up for final action. On motion, seconded and carried was duly declared passed. Yeas 8, nays 0.

On motion, seconded and carried, Council adjourned.
